Role of Nonprofit Advisory Council (revision of Nonprofit Network Advisory Council in 2020):

The Nonprofit Advisory Council is an advisory council to the Greater Cedar Rapids Community Foundation Staff and Board of Directors and provides counsel on activities and programs of the Community Foundation.

The council will advise on efforts to promote visibility and showcase the accomplishments of the nonprofit community. In addition, the council will provide counsel on Community Foundation activities and programs from the nonprofit perspective.

Council members are invited to join the council and serve a three-year term. They are eligible for a second term after completion of their first term. Typically, a council member is a CEO or Executive Director of a Linn County nonprofit organization. Four meetings are held per year.
